

Southwest Academy Transportation Information for the 2022-2023 School Year

Baltimore County Office of Transportation is working tirelessly to assign buses for students around the county. Transportation information will be shared with families by **Southwest Academy** through the following formats:



A **phone call** through the school messaging system to all SWA families the week of August 22, 2022, indicating the bus that the student is assigned to.



An **email and text** to all SWA families the week of August 22, 2022, indicating the assigned bus and the bus stops associated with the assigned bus.

Additional Transportation Information

- Students who live within 1.0 miles door to door of Southwest Academy are assigned as a walker.
- Seventh and Eighth graders who live in the same residence as last school year will most likely be assigned the same bus and stop as the previous year, however, they should still ensure that they are riding the bus that has been assigned to them prior to August 29, 2022.
